TRUTH 3: HONOR HIS NAME

Study Verse Section: **You shall not take** [Heb. לֹא תִשָּׂא lit. to raise up Qal Imperfect verb denoting a habitual action still in progress] **the name of the LORD** [Heb. אֶת־שְׁמִי־יְהוָה YHWH—I AM] **your God** [Heb. אֱלֹהֵיךָ Elohim—plural name for God] **in vain** [Heb. לְשׁוֹן lit. worthless or empty], **for the LORD will not hold him guiltless** [Heb. לֹא יַנְקֶה lit. not leave unpunished] **who takes his name in vain.**

1. THE NAME OF GOD

Represents His Essence

Exodus 20:7 (ESV)- “You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the Lord will not hold him guiltless who takes his name in vain.”

Leviticus 11:45 (ESV)- “For I am the LORD who brought you up out of the land of Egypt to be your God. You shall therefore be holy, for I am holy.”

Represents His Reputation

TRUTH 3: HONOR HIS NAME
