1. THE LIE

2. THE LOSS

3. THE LOST

1 Samuel 22:1-2 (ESV)-David departed from there and escaped to the cave of Adullam. And when his brothers and all his father's house heard it, they went down there to him. And everyone who was in distress, and everyone who was in debt, and everyone who was bitter in soul, gathered to him. And he became commander over them. And there were with him about four hundred men.

What are Caves?

1. A Place of Revealing

Psalm 142:1-2 (ESV)- With my voice I cry out to the Lord; with my voice I plead for mercy to the Lord. I pour out my complaint before him; I tell my trouble before him.

In the cave we learn honesty.

2. A Place of Reliance

Psalm 142:3 (ESV)- When my spirit faints within me, you know my way! In the path where I walk they have hidden a trap for me.

In the cave we learn dependence.

3. A Place of Refuge

Psalm 142:4-5 (ESV)-Look to the right and see: there is none who takes notice of me; no refuge remains to me; no one cares for my soul. I cry to you, O Lord; I say, “You are my refuge my portion in the land of the living.

In the cave we learn love.

4. A Place of Refining

Psalm 142:6 (ESV)-Attend to my cry, for I am brought very low! Deliver me from my persecutors, for they are too strong for me!

In the cave we learn empathy.

He makes you nothing before he makes you something.

5. A Place of Reassurance

Psalm 142:7 (ESV)-Bring me out of prison, that I may give thanks to your name! The righteous will surround me, for you will deal bountifully with me.

In the cave we learn faith.
