#### HISTORICAL CONTEXT

Paul wrote the letter from Prison. (Philippians 1:7,13,17)

Most likely imprisoned in Rome. (Philippians 1:13)

Written between 55A.D.-62A.D.

Philippi was established in 356 B.C.

The city was very Roman both in culture and ethnicity.

Very little Jewish population.

Paul had no intention of starting a church in Philippi.

Paul was imprisoned during his time in Philippi

Church in Philippi supported Paul after he left.

Written by Paul.

The word **joy**  $(\chi\alpha\rho\dot{\alpha})$  Chara appears 5 times,

The word **rejoice** (χαίρω) Chairein appears 9 times

There are 104 verses in Philippians and half contain Jesus.

#### PAUL FINDS HIS JOY IN...

## 1. THE RIGHT PERSPECTIVE ABOUT HIMSELF

Philippians 1:1a. (ESV)- Paul and Timothy, servants of Christ Jesus,

**Word Study:** Servants (δοῦλος)- one who is wholly committed to another.

Proverbs 3:5-6 (ESV)-Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and <u>do not</u> lean on your own understanding.

## 2. THE RIGHT PERSPECTIVE ABOUT OTHERS

Philippians 1:1 (ESV)-Paul and Timothy, servants of Christ Jesus, <u>To all the saints in Christ Jesus</u> who are at Philippi, with the overseers and deacons:

Philippians 2:3 (ESV)- Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves.

# 3. THE RIGHT PERSPECTIVE ABOUT THE SOURCE

Philippians 1:2 (ESV)- Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

John 15:11 (ESV)- These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full.

### 4. THE RIGHT PERSPECTIVE ABOUT THE PAST

Philippians 1:3 (ESV)-I thank my God in <u>all my remembrance</u> of you

Acts 16:22-23 (ESV)-The crowd joined in attacking them, and the magistrates tore the garments off them and gave orders to <u>beat them</u> <u>with rods</u>. And <u>when they had inflicted many blows upon them</u>, they threw them into prison, ordering the jailer to keep them safely.

Philippians 1:12 (ESV)-I want you to know, brothers, that <u>what has happened to me has really served to advance the gospel,</u>

**Here is the Point:** Joy is found with right perspective!
