Disciples Love

1. LOVE UNCONDITIONALLY

John 13:31 (ESV)- A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another:

People with me

Mark 12:30-31 (ESV)-And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.' The second is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself. There is no other commandment greater than these.

People around me

Matthew 5:43-44 (ESV)-You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' But I say to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you,

People against me

2. LOVE SACRIFICIALLY

John 13:31 (ESV)-just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another.

John 15:12 (ESV)-"This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends.

I John 3:16 (ESV)-By this we know love, that he laid down his life for us, and we ought to lay down our lives for the brothers.

3. LOVE DEPENDENTLY

John 13:35 (ESV)-By this all people will know that you are my disciples.

John 17:26b (ESV)-...that the love with which you have loved me may be in them, and I in them.
